**Wednesday the 30<sup>th</sup> of November 9- 12am**

**“Living Awareness and HIV/AIDS”- front lawn of the Wagga Base Hospital  
Edward Street**

The Wagga Sexual Health Service will partner with Wagga Women’s Health Clinic to assist with their visual display. The red ribbon will be painted on the grass. Red pot plants, red ribbon cup cakes and resources will be given away.

**Friday the 25<sup>th</sup> of November to Thursday the 1<sup>st</sup> of December**

**Wagga Base Hospital Chapel- to enter take the lift to the first floor and is situated near the children’s Ward**

This will be a dedicated space for remembrance. Red ribbons will be available.

**Thursday the 1<sup>st</sup> of December “Play safe” Wagga Marketplace**

Mission Australia will be hosting a stall to raise community and youth awareness of HIV.

**Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> of November to Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup> of December**

A banner will be displayed at the suburb of Bowman, encouraging community support for World AIDS Day. This is on the main road into Wagga from Junee/Temora.

**Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> November to Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup> of December**

A World AIDS Awareness Week sign will be displayed at the corner of Edward and Docker St. It will feature a banner underneath with personal health staff messages of support for people living with HIV.

**Wagga City Library book club will feature the book and DVD**

“And The Band Played On: Politics, People, and the AIDS Epidemic” by Randy Shilts Books, discussion notes and resources will be circulated amongst the book club-launched on the 30<sup>th</sup> November.

**Thursday the 1<sup>st</sup> of December**

**Wagga City Council “light up” Red display**

Various buildings in the council precinct will utilise red lighting in support for World AIDS Day, these include; Fountain in the Victory Memorial Gardens, Civic Theatre upstairs foyer, and Historic Council Chambers foyer.
